Stat. § 13D.01, Subd. 3 and 13D.05 Subd. 3(b), a non-public special meeting of Litigation Review Committee be held on Friday, April 28, 2023 at 8:00 a.m. in the West Committee Room, 600 McNamara Alumni Center for the purpose of discussing attorney-client privileged matters including the following:

- I. Regents of the University of Minnesota v. AT&T, et al.
- II. Threatened claim by current employee.
